The Lower North Thompson Community Forest Society (LNTCFS) is seeking two motivated students for employment through the summer of 2017.

Job Description:

Students will receive training and work experience in various forestry activities including:

- manual mechanical brushing
- silviculture surveys and planting quality assessments
- timber reconnaissance and development work (block layout, Site Plan data collection, forest health assessments, riparian assessments, etc.)

The LNTCFS requires candidates with the following traits:

- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills and able to work with minimal supervision
- Able to work well in a team environment
- Willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions and able to thrive in a physically demanding work environment
- Previous experience in manual brushing, silviculture surveys, and/or forest development an asset
- Have compass orientation, mapping, and iPad skills
- Valid BC Class 5 driver's license

Qualifications:

To be eligible, students must:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- have been registered as full-time students in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act²; and,
- be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.

Wage: Based on education and experience
